**As of January 8, 2021, we are already serving Phase 1 A (frontline health workers/long-term care staff) and Phase 1B Group 1 (those over 75)**

**If you're a patient in the Atrium Health system:**

- >Log in to your <https://my.atriumhealth.org> and select COVID prescreen ( right side menu at bottom of choices). {It will make you log in again}
- >Complete the screening form and you'll be notified when appointments open for your group (Phase 1B Group 2 for educators over 50)
- > When notified, log back in to schedule an appointment\*

**If you're not a patient of either the Atrium Health or Novant Health systems and live in Mecklenburg County**
